CONTINUING EDUCATION INFORMATION

TO RECEIVE A CERTIFICATE FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDIT, YOU MUST:

1. Review the conference program before the conference begins. It contains important information regarding your continuing education credit.
2. Register for CE credits *prior* the conference, and pay the **additional \$60 CE fee**. You must provide the type of credits, and your state and professional license number. NOTE: Our accrediting boards do not accept retroactive CE credit requests. You must sign up and pay for a CE certificate before the conclusion of the conference.
3. You will receive credit for the sessions you attend that qualify for CE/CME credit. You must attend the entire session in order to receive credit for that session AND you must attend the **live session**.
4. Complete the online evaluation. Instructions for completing the evaluation are included on the next page. Once you have completed the evaluation, YOU CAN PRINT YOUR OWN CE CERTIFICATE. **We can't give you a certificate.**

AVAILABLE CREDIT AND CLARIFICATION OF TERMINOLOGY

Continuing education credit is available for professional educators and many healthcare Professionals. If you plan to purchase credit here, please do so before the conclusion of the conference. You may not register for credit after the conference concludes. This restriction is imposed by our accrediting agencies, and we are not able to make exceptions to it. Continuing education terminology varies from profession to profession and can be confusing. Generally speaking, "clock hours", "contact hours", and "continuing education credits" all refer, or are calculated on the basis of, time actually spent in training.

IBH awards one continuing education credit for each 60 minutes of training received. Luncheon and scheduled breaks 15 minutes or longer are not counted toward clock hours/credits awarded. The exact number of credits/clock hours you'll receive for attending the conference will depend on the specific break out sessions you attend. This calculation will be made for you automatically when you complete the online evaluation form at the end of the course, and will appear on your certificate of completion. Neither Professional Development Points (PDPs) nor college credit will be awarded for the conference, though participants are free to make their own arrangements regarding the use of credits earned. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR EDUCATION PROFESSIONALS

How to Obtain Your CE/CME Certificate

Please follow these steps to access your course evaluation and CE certificate through IBH's online portal. Please read through all of the instructions below before proceeding.

1. At the conference, you will receive a unique web link to complete the post workshop evaluation process. By following this link, you will arrive on the IBH-Join Event webpage.
2. In the first field provided, enter the email address you used to register for the course.
